

# GENEROSO M. SENAL

*Officer in Charge*

Mr. Generoso M. Senal is the Officer-in-Charge of the National Transmission Corporation (TransCo) starting September 1, 2015.

He is a Registered Electrical Engineer (REE) and a Career Executive Service (CES) Eligible.

Concurrently, he is also Vice President of TransCo's Concession Contract Management Group (CCMG). As head of CCMG, Mr. Senal provides overall management and direction in monitoring the Transmission Concessionaire's compliance with the technical provisions of the Concession Agreement and Transaction Documents, in technical and regulatory matters pertaining to TransCo, in the divestment of sub-transmission assets and administration of the Feed-in-Tariff Allowance Fund.

From 2005 to January 2009, he was Assistant Vice President for Corporate Planning. As such, he took charge of the preparation of the Transmission Development Plan (TDP), which is an EPIRA-mandated function, as well as TransCo's compliance with ERC regulations and orders.

He also acted as Chair of TransCo's Asset Valuation Project preparatory to the 2006-2010 regulatory period and was directly involved in the regulatory process for the Maximum Allowable Revenue (MAR) 2006-2010 Application of TransCo as well as in negotiations for the signing of Transmission Service Agreements (TSA).

Mr. Senal completed his B.S. Electrical Engineering degree at Adamson University in 1974 and passed the REE board examination in the same year.
