

Additional Terms and Conditions:

1. The Chemicals/insecticides should be registered and approved by the Philippines Fertilizer and Pesticide Authority (FPA), Food and Drug Administration (FDA) and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
2. Chemical quantity should be sealed and in original packaging 50% to be delivered one week prior to 1st treatment, 50% one week prior the 7th treatment.
3. Frequency of treatment is twice a month . Within 3 days after treatment, contractor shall conduct ocular inspection to the site to determine effectiveness of the treatment so necessary adjustments shall be made.
4. The prospective bidder must conduct an ocular inspection of the site where the general pest control activities will be done and must secure a certificate of ocular inspection from GSD.
5. The prospective bidder must submit work and safety program on the implementation the general pest control in their quotation for evaluation.
6. For every fogging operations the contractor must submit to Transco a permit issued by the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP).
7. Alternative Chemical type other than the required will; be rejected.
8. Chemical dilution should be witnessed by GSD personnel or assigned janitorial personnel every treatment.
9. Manufacturing date of all chemical to be deliver: shall be year 2016 and Warranty of chemicals: 3 years
