In the exigencies of the service and as duly approved by the TransCo Board of Directors under Resolution No. TC2015-011 dated 26 August 2015, Vice President GENEROSO M. SENAL is hereby designated as OIC of the National Transmission Corporation (TransCo) effective 01 September 2015.


- 1) As TransCo OIC, Vice President Senal is authorized to:
  - a. Represent TransCo in transactions with other offices, agencies and other instrumentalities of the government and other private entities;
  - b. Direct and supervise TransCo's day-to-day operations/internal administration, including delegation of some or any of such responsibilities and duties to other officers of TransCo. The OIC may designate other officers to positions whose functions are vital and necessary to the operations of TransCo;
  - c. Sign, execute, perform and deliver those contracts, agreements already approved by the TransCo Board for the TransCo President and CEO to execute but the actual execution of which shall occur upon the effective period of this Office Order;
  - d. Execute and administer the policies and measures approved by the TransCo Board;
  - e. Sign Service Agreements/individual Contracts of Service and appointment papers of plantilla personnel to meet the manpower requirements of TransCo; and
  - f. Seek further authority from the TransCo Board on necessary action/s in the interest of the service and in furtherance of the corporate mandate of TransCo that may not have been expressly provided or delegated herein.

- 2) Vice President Senal shall be entitled to reimbursable Representation and Transportation Allowance and other allowances corresponding to that of a President and CEO, subject to existing policies, accounting and auditing laws, rules and regulations.
- 3) In connection with the exercise of authority emanating from this Office Order, the designated OIC is hereby enjoined to observe relevant laws, policies, rules and regulations to ensure the legality and validity of all acts performed pursuant to this Order.
- 4) This Order shall continue to be in force until modified or revoked by the TransCo Board or when the President and CEO of TransCo is appointed and/or has assumed office in TransCo.
