

TransCo maintains ISO 9001:2015 Certification



The National Transmission Corporation (TransCo) officially received its ISO 9001:2015 Certification for its Quality Management System (QMS) on 16 December 2021, following its successful ISO Recertification Audit in October 2021.

The scope of the Certification covers TransCo's business processes such as concession contact management, settlement of right-of-way claims, divestment of sub-transmission assets, operation and maintenance of electrical systems of contracted economic zones, and administration of the Feed-in-Tariff Allowance Fund.

The Recertification, as attested by external auditor SOCOTEC, confirms that the Corporation operates an effective management system that conforms to the international standards.
